A new focus for cooperation

Sport is now a strong focus of AFD's strategy, especially in Africa.Our aim is to assist our partners in implementing sustainable development paths.

- The launch of a platform for transformation through sport was announced by President Emmanuel Macron in February 2018, during a reception for Liberian President and former soccer star George Weah. Its objective is to establish international partnerships and develop local initiatives for community sport and social cohesion.
- In the French overseas territories, the partnership with the French National Center for the Development of Sport (CNDS) supports innovative sport infrastructure projects.
- AFD has for many years been financing municipal sport infrastructure (neighborhood stadiums, swimming pools, etc.) in the countries where it operates.
- The support for the projects of French CSOs such as Play International, a non-profit association accredited by the French Ministry of Sport which been working in Burundi since 2016 – promotes access to education through sport.

A means for achieving the SDGs

Paris has made sustainable development a key component of the project to organize the major international sporting events of the 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

- Sport is a tool for cohesion and development. It can make a significant contribution to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the 109 countries where AFD operates.
- The SDGs mention sport as a key factor through its "contribution to peace, the empowerment of women and of young people, as well as to the achievement of health, education and social inclusion objectives".
- Sport is a vehicle for France's outreach, which requires being a model of sustainable development in order to showcase French know-how.

Bernard States 3 Focus 3 on community sport

AFD's aim with its Sport and Development activities is to promote community sport by supporting local initiatives for social cohesion.

- Community sport is a powerful ingredient for social inclusion, as well as a factor for empowerment and self-esteem for girls and women.
- With 70% of Africa's population today under 30, the organization of the sector in Africa needs to be improved.
- To promote community sport, it is essential to renovate infrastructure for people living in the most underprivileged neighborhoods, which requires diversified modes of financing.

Support for a rapidly developing economic sector

AFD, with its subsidiary PROPARCO, aims to mobilize the private sector in the countries where it operates in order to develop a dynamic sport sector (equipment manufacturers, sustainable infrastructure, training schools, etc).

- Sport is a rapidly developing economic sector which can act as a driver for development in certain regions of the world. It is a vehicle for the creation of economic wealth for which France can provide its expertise.
- The organization of the 2024 Olympic Games is a unique opportunity to get several sectors to work together towards a common objective of promoting France's international range of activities.



AFD has financial products tailored to development through sport.

- For public investments for sustainable sport: sovereign or nonsovereign concessional loans for the construction of sustainable sport infrastructure.
- For private investments for the economy of sustainable sport: loans on market terms *via* our subsidiary PROPARCO, equity investments, banking intermediation and the Fund for Technical Expertise and Experience Transfers (FEXTE).
- Initiatives for social cohesion are taken into account by AFD's NGO window and the French Local Authorities Financing Facility (FICOL).
