



AFD Group's 2022 Results

In 2022, AFD Group fulfilled its objectives with €12.3 billion of new financing signed, for more than 1,000 new projects. The Group's subsidiaries, Proparco and now Expertise France, made a significant contribution to these results. Proparco, with €1.8 billion of projects signed and Expertise France, whose activity has tripled in size since 2015, with close to €400 million of business volume in 2022. This year was also marked by the mobilization of a number of French and international partners, which helped take French development policy to new heights.

Marked by the return of war on the European continent, its impact on food security and unprecedented heat waves, 2022 propelled us into 'an age of consequences'. Our Group is doing its bit to confront these challenges, with commitment and effectiveness. We're doing this by maintaining a high level of financial ambition, by reinforcing our technical cooperation with the arrival of Expertise France, and by transforming our institution into a platform to mobilize partners who share our objectives and wish to cooperate with France. With the 26 members of the International Development Finance Club (IDFC) and the 530 Public Development Banks of the Finance in Common Summit (FiCS) movement, the partnership dynamics show that they alone are able to counter the fragmentation of the world and engage in a just and sustainable transition.

In its first year of existence, the expanded AFD Group...

...helped take French development policy to new heights

This level reached 0.56% of our gross national income, making France the world's fourth largest contributor of Official Development Assistance in terms of volume. With a record €9 billion disbursed, AFD Group is supported by two powerful and complementary subsidiaries. Proparco, dedicated to the private sector, in particular led the Choose Africa initiative. Launched in 2018, this initiative has financed around 40,000 MSMEs and several hundreds of thousands of microentrepreneurs in Africa. Expertise France,France's

interministerial agency responsible for technical cooperation, now employs around 1,000 experts in 380 projects. 65% of its business volume is generated in Africa.

...took concrete action, with its partners in France

In 2022, AFD Group continued to mobilize a broad range of partners in France and all over the world. Some 275

French and international civil society organizations were directly supported in 2022. The Group is also working on decentralized cooperation projects with 53 French regional and local authorities. And more than 70% of projects being implemented involve at least one French economic actor. Furthermore, 8% of French middle and high school students were informed about the main issues of sustainable development and international solidarity. And more than 3.5 million young people were reached on social networks, in particular by *Tilt!*, the dedicated media coordinated by AFD.

...Europe and worldwide

As the leading partner of the World Bank for the number of projects and the leading recipient of funds delegated by the European Commission, AFD Group mobilizes a large number of partner institutions. AFD Group helps structure Team Europe within the JEFIC, EDFI and Practitioners' Network platforms. AFD is working on the Summit for a New Global Financial Pact to be held in Paris on 22 and 23 June 2023 and is engaged in the Finance in Common (FiCS) movement. AFD Group is also an official partner of Paris 2024.

...backed by French citizens

The annual survey commissioned by AFD shows a growing interest in development issues among French people. About 80% recognize the interdependence between developing countries and their daily lives, with the protection of the planet increasingly a concern. More and more of the French public also support France's development policy.
