


Research at AFD: five signature programs...

Fiscal impact analyses

to assess the effects on poverty and inequality from a country's taxes and social spending

ESGAP indicator

to assess a region's environmental sustainability

GEMMES model

to identify opportunities and vulnerabilities related to ecological and energy-transition scenarios

Analysis of inequalities

to exhaustively analyze the multiple dimensions of inequalities, at different scales

Analysis of climate-related financial risks

to assess such risks as part of a country's transition to a lowcarbon economy

ESTEEM model


to analyze how a country will be affected fiscally, socio-economically, and externally by its low-carbon transition




