










Africa remains a priority for AFD Group in this sector, with almost 40% of financing and 50% of projects.

In 2023, projects financed by AFD - both ongoing and completed - allowed:

248,000 people, including 99,700 women, to benefit from nutrition-focused projects

## Projects with an impact on the ground

In 2023, projects financed by AFD - both ongoing and completed - allowed approximately:

**51,400** hectares of agricultural land to begin conversion to agro-ecological farming

Over 1.2 million people to benefit from biodiversity conservation or restoration work

#### 1,470 local land management institutions

to receive support

**34 million hectares of natural land** areas to benefit from biodiversity conservation or restoration programs

#### **Over 10 million** hectares of land

to benefit from sustainable resource and/or land management programs

**5.1 million people** to see their access to basic equipment, infrastructure and services improved on a long-term basis
