The Biodiversity Partners Program assists project initiators from the public, private and civil society sectors with the implementation of their projects for nature. It also supports the creation of regional communities of actors fighting against biodiversity loss.

The program is supported by the AFD Campus, AFD's training center for actors working to promote transitions in AFD's countries of operation.



#### **Objectives**

Understand the issues of biodiversity and ecological leadership.

Participate in a face-to-face project acceleration sequence (hackathon)<sup>(1)</sup> to accelerate pronature projects.

Discover tools, entrepreneurial know-how and benefit from coaching to advance projects.

## **Beneficiaries**

Intrapreneurs with a nature project within their organization (such as ministries, companies and banks)

Entrepreneurs (NGOs, civil society and private sector) with a minimum of six months of activity and an innovative project with impacts on biodiversity

Eligible countries: Southern and North Africa

**Type of instrument:** Grant

**Content:** 6-month acceleration and training program:

- Theoretical lessons on biodiversity issues
- Practical exercises through the ecological leadership posture
- Discovery of entrepreneurial tools and knowhow to accelerate projects

- Breakout Sessions
- In-person project acceleration sequence (hackathon)<sup>(1)</sup>
