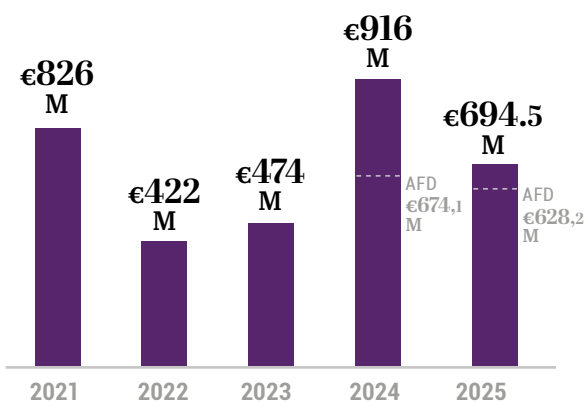

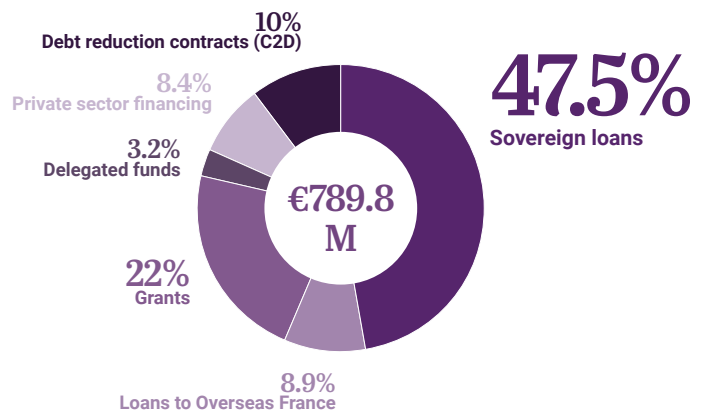

BREAKDOWN BY FINANCIAL INSTRUMENT (2025)



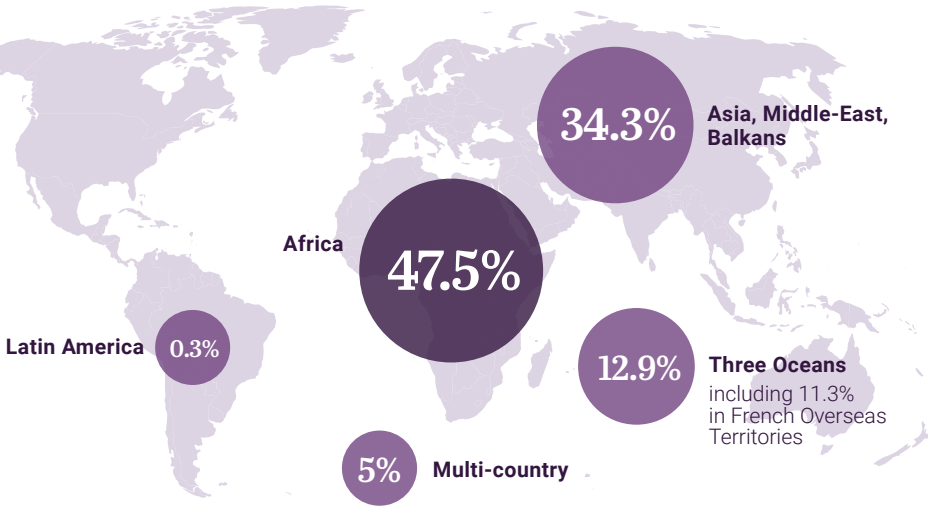

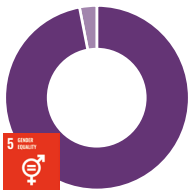

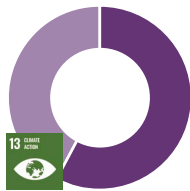
GEOGRAPHICAL DISTRIBUTION OF AFD COMMITMENTS



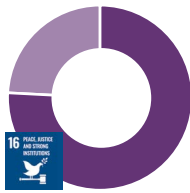
EXPECTED SDG IMPACTS OF PROJECTS IN 2025 (BY AMOUNTS)
