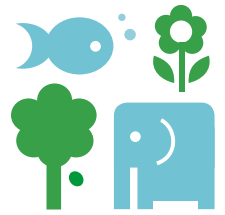

A renewed ambition for the climate, nature, and people

In 2025, AFD Group financing for climate and biodiversity reached a record level, with an increased share devoted to adaptation and projects with systemic impacts. AFD Group has adopted a “Planet” roadmap with ambitions that match the scale of the climate and biodiversity challenges.

Climate and nature highlights in 2025

- A new roadmap 100% in line with the Paris Agreement and the Global Biodiversity Framework
- Record results, in both volume and quality, on climate and biodiversity
- 63% of AFD Group's activity contributed to the climate or nature

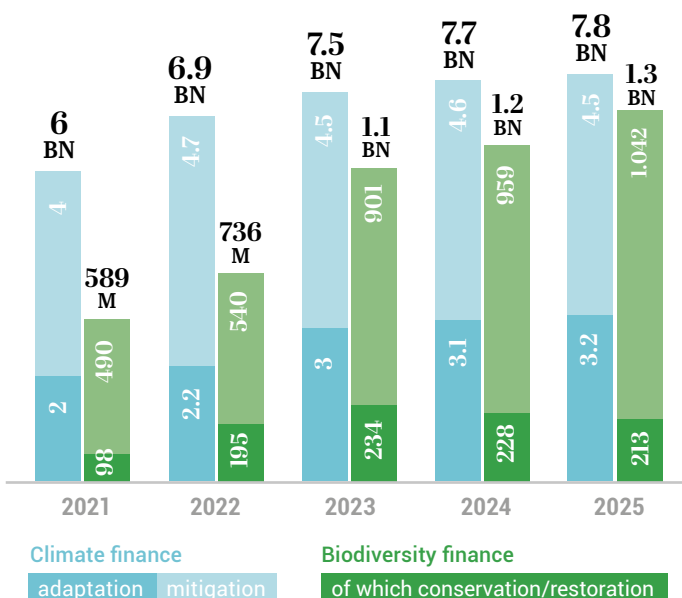

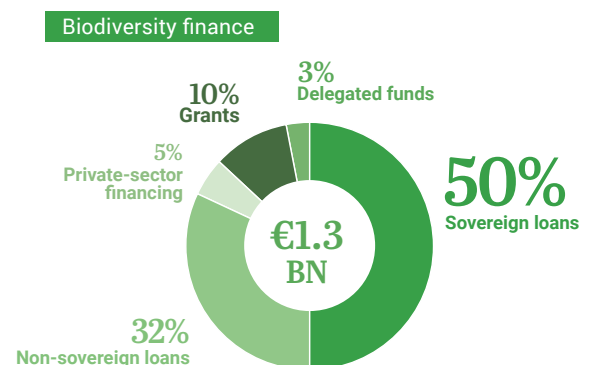
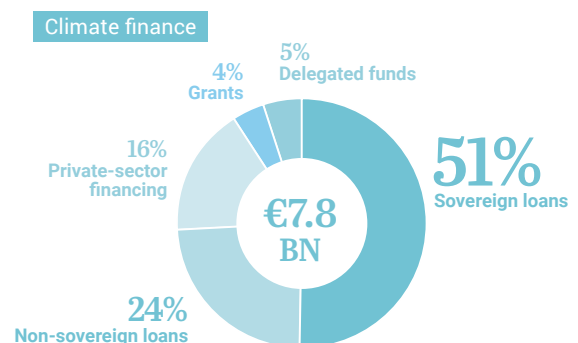

BREAKDOWN BY FINANCIAL TOOL 2025

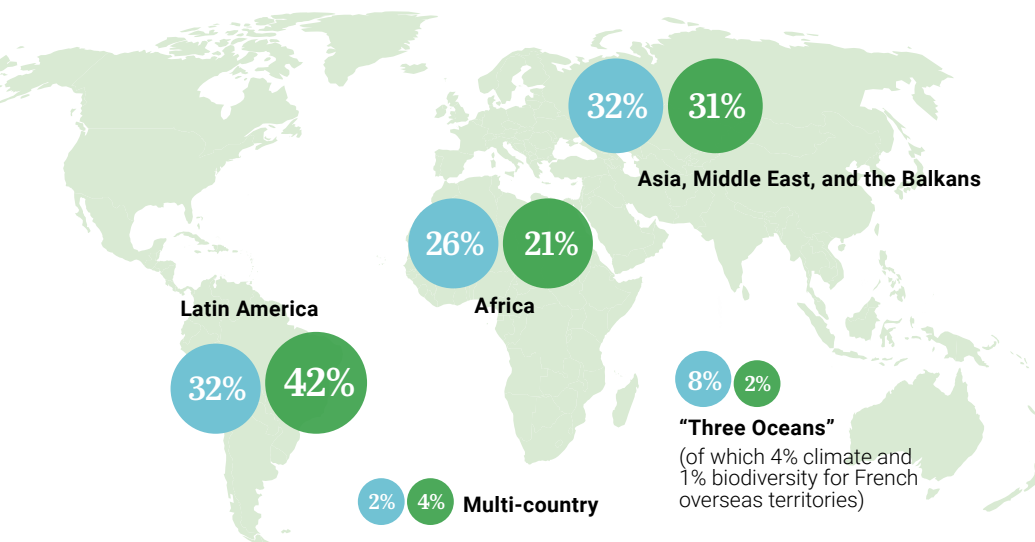

GEOGRAPHICAL BREAKDOWN OF AFD COMMITMENTS

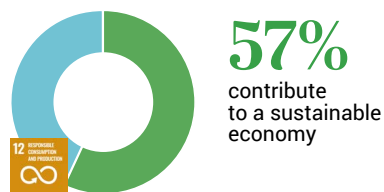
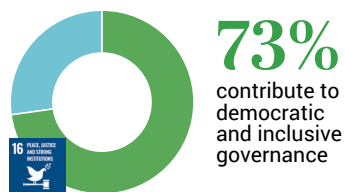
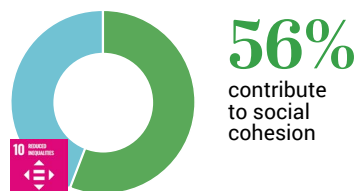
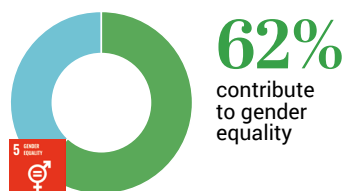
Climate finance

Biodiversity finance



In 2025, climate finance was divided between Africa, Latin America and the Asia/Middle East/Balkans area (approx. 30% each), with €342 million devoted to the French overseas territories. Biodiversity finance increased in Latin America (+56% in 2025 compared to 2024).

Support to French NGOs for climate mobilization



The PAMOC program, organized with Coordination SUD since 2010, works to integrate climate considerations into the projects, advocacy, and operations of French NGOs and their partners in the Global South. Its 2022-2025 phase has already reached 150 organizations.
